



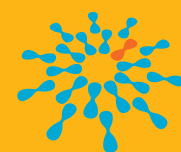
Rare Cancer Coalition

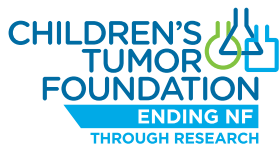
