As the VP of Finance of NORD, Vincent Murphy is responsible for all the financial matters of the organization. This includes oversight of NORD's accounting functions, which includes the payroll and accounts payable and accounts receivable functions of the organization. In addition, Vin is responsible for financial reporting to NORD's stakeholders and working with its Board Members, its bankers and its auditors. Also, as the VP of Finance, Vin is responsible for overseeing the development of NORD's annual budget as well as long-term financial forecasts and the financial aspects of the organization's Strategic Plan.

Vin is a seasoned nonprofit finance professional with over 20 years of experience, including 12 years in health care. Prior to joining NORD, he worked as consultant for Ariadne Labs, a joint venture of the Harvard T.H. Chan School of Public Health and Brigham and Women's Hospital. At Ariadne, Vin oversaw the selection and ultimately the successful implementation of a cloud based budgeting and financial reporting tool which led to more accurate and timely budgeting and financial reporting for the organization.

Before consulting for Ariadne Labs, Vin was the Controller of BPE, a nonprofit educational organization located in Boston. In addition, to running the accounting function of the organization, he oversaw the upgrade of a new cloud based payroll and timesheet system. Before BPE, Vin was the Assistant Controller at WGBH Educational Foundation, where he directed the successful merger of the accounting department at its subsidiary station WGBY located in Springfield, MA, into the main accounting department located in Brighton, MA. He also was part of the team that implemented an internal compliance department that was created to ensure compliance with all of the requirements of the federal grants WGBH had been awarded. Prior to WGBH Vin was the controller at various non-profit long-term health care facilities in Massachusetts.

In addition, to having a Certified Public Accounting license from the Division of Accountancy of Massachusetts, Vin earned an MBA in Accountancy from Bentley College in Waltham, MA, and a BA in Financial Economics from Saint Anselm College in Manchester, NH.
