Dear Chair Liebling:

Thank you for granting House File 633 a hearing in your committee on March 1, and for your warm reception for the legislation. As you deliberate on your priority items for the Health Finance and Policy omnibus bill, our organizations encourage you to include Representative Bierman’s bill in your omnibus package.

On March 1, multiple witnesses spoke and wrote about the need for HF 633. Metastatic breast cancer survivor Monica Theis shared what it’s like to take on debt every year to make the lump-sum payment on the medications that keep her alive. Specialty pharmacist Brian Arnold testified about the many patients he meets who share Monica’s pain and worry. Government affairs director Dana Bacon reviewed real-world market and regulatory evidence from Colorado to explain how copay-only plans serve these patients without harming other consumers or health plans.
